#### Central Texas Regional Mobility Authority

The Board Members and staff of the Central Texas Regional Mobility Authority honor and appreciate the service of the men and women of our military forces, past and present. State law allows a Texas toll road entity to offer discounted or free tolls to Congressional Medal of Honor, Legion of Valor and Purple Heart recipients as well as disabled veterans who qualify and meet the requirements for specialty license plates. Effective November 1, 2018, the Mobility Authority offers a discounted toll program to these valued service members.

#### Qualified Veterans Use of METRO HOT Lanes (Metropolitan Transit Authority of Harris County, Texas)

Honoring the Brave: METRO is offering all qualified U.S. military veterans discounted travel on the METRO HOT Lanes network. If you have a Disabled Veteran, Medal of Honor, Legion of Valor or Purple Heart license plate on your vehicle - you're eligible to receive discount tolls on the METRO HOT Lanes Network.

#### Fort Bend County Toll Road Authority (FBCTRA)

It is the policy of the Fort Bend County Toll Road Authority (FBCTRA) to offer discounted tolls to all Disabled Veterans, Purple Heart, and Legion of Valor recipients who have the qualifying license plates and are registered. FBCTRA operates an all-electronic tolling system. To receive the discount the system must be able to properly identify the vehicle electronically through the use of toll tags such as the HCTRA EZ-Tag, TxTag, or NTTA Toll Tag.
